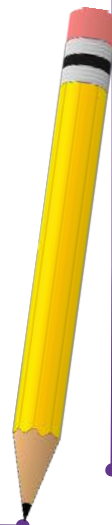


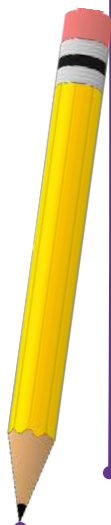

Ask the preschooler to identify all of the members of their family. Work with the preschool student to write out the name of every family member. Ask the students to draw a family portrait.



Ask the preschooler to tell you about their favorite food. Encourage them to try to spell the word themselves and ask them to draw a picture of the meal.
